

An Aloha Message to our Kapalua Golfers

We are excited to have you back! We want all of our valued golfers to know what you can to help us create an enjoyable and safe Plantation Golf experience. To ensure everyone's health to the greatest possible degree, we are following the **COVID-19 Pandemic Guidelines** as mandated by the CDC, The Hawaii State Department of Health, and the Aloha Section Professional Golfers' Association. As we endeavor to keep our island paradise safe, we ask for your kind cooperation by respecting the following guidelines:

1. **Social Distance** - Golfers **must maintain at least 6 feet of social distancing** at all times.
2. **Face coverings** - Any time a golfer is within 6 feet of another golfer or staff, whether the golfer is in a golf cart; walking the course; on the range or practice green; or inside any part of the golf facility, golfers **must wear a face covering**.
3. **Golf Bags** - Staff will not touch or handle a golfer's golf equipment or vehicle at any time, unless requested by the golfer.
4. **Golf Carts** - If a golf cart is shared by two riders from different households (either on the course or in use by staff), **both riders must wear a face covering** while in the cart. The driver or operator must remain in control of the cart throughout the round or until sanitized for the next operator. Golf carts' high touch points are sanitized both pre and post round. Single carts are available for golfers over 60 years of age or for those who are deemed to be "High-Risk" per CDC criteria.
5. **Arrival Time and Departure** – To avoid gatherings, all golfers are requested to arrive **no more than 30 minutes** prior to their tee time and to leave as soon as possible after their round is completed.
6. **Flags** - There is a raised foam base in each hole. **It is prohibited to touch or remove the flag from the hole.**
7. **Golf Club Rentals** - Rental equipment is available. Please contact Reservations prior to your round.
8. **Cart amenities** – Due to mandated guidelines, the following will not be provided: wet towels, sand bottles, bunker rakes, bottled water, on course water coolers
9. **On-course Food & Beverage** – Golfers will be allowed to bring their own non-alcoholic beverages and food on the course. Outside alcohol on the golf course is not permitted by law.
10. The practice range and Clubhouse at the Plantation Golf Course are currently closed. Restrooms are located by the range; between holes #5 & #6; and after hole #14.
11. We ask that all tee times to be prepaid in advance on-line.
